Weapons Policy

- 1. All weapons must be peace bonded. Peace bonding at Mile Hi Con consists of an orange tie placed prominently on the weapon. This is to signify that you are aware of the Policy. Peace bonding materials may be gotten in Operations.
- 2. All weapons must have a sheath, holster or other carrying device. Weapons may not be brandished and must remain slung or holstered. There are three places where a weapon may be waved about and they are Operations, the dealers room (with permission of the vendor) and in your sleeping room with the door closed.
- 3. No real looking guns. (no real guns either)
- 4. No lasers more powerful than OSHA class 3 are allowed.
- 5. Any question of what constitutes a weapon and how the Policy is interpreted (or enforced) is reserved by the convention.
- 6. Failure to comply with the above rules or to be peace bonded may result in ejection from the convention
