

Friday – Open 6pm-midnight

- 6:00** FLCL (1-5, subtitled, TV-14)
Naota is a normal Japanese 6th grade boy, but when his older brother leaves for America to play baseball, his brother leaves his 17 year old girlfriend Mamimi behind. Mamimi is sending mixed signals and advances to Naota, and he doesn't know what to do about her. But to make matters worse, Naota's world is totally turned upside down when he is run over by a woman on a Vespa.
- 8:00** Boogiepop and Others (1-5, subtitled, TV-14)
Hushed exchanges among the female students of Shinyo Academy center around Boogiepop, a Shinigami who is rumored to murder people at the height of their beauty before their allure wanes. Few know of his true nature: a guardian who, between periods of dormancy, manifests as the alter ego of a high school girl named Touka Miyashita to fend off “the enemies of the world.”
- 10:00** Wonder Egg Priority (1-5, dubbed, TV-MA)
Content note: depictions of suicide and bullying
Following the suicide of her best and only friend, Ai Ooto is left grappling with her new reality. With nothing left to live for, she follows the instructions of a mysterious entity and gets roped into purchasing a Wonder Egg. Upon breaking the egg, Ai is tasked with saving people from the adversities that come their way. In doing so, she believes that she has moved closer to saving her best friend.

- 8:00** Kamisama Kiss (1-4, subtitled, TV-PG)
Nanami Momozono has quite a few problems of late, beginning with her absentee father being in such extreme debt that they lose everything. Downtrodden and homeless, she runs into a man being harassed by a dog. After helping him, she explains her situation, and to her surprise, he offers her his home in gratitude. But when she discovers that said home is a rundown shrine, she tries to leave; however, she is caught by two shrine spirits and a fox familiar named Tomoe. They mistake her for the man Nanami rescued—the land god of the shrine, Mikage.
- 9:30** Somali and the Forest Spirit (1-3, dubbed, TV-14)
In a world inhabited by demons, cyclopes, and other fantastic creatures, humans stand apart as the outcasts. One day, Golem, a wandering protector of nature, encounters a lone human child while patrolling. Inspired by her enthusiasm, he takes the girl, named Somali, under his wing. Together, the duo embarks on a journey to find Somali's parents and bring her home.
- 11:00** Beyond the Boundary (1-4, subtitled, TV-14)
Mirai Kuriyama is tasked with hunting down and killing "youmu"—creatures born of negative human emotions. One day, while deep in thought on the school roof, Mirai comes across Akihito Kanbara, a rare half-breed of youmu in human form. Panicked, she plunges her blood saber into him only to realize that he's an immortal being. The two form an impromptu friendship that revolves around Mirai constantly trying to kill Akihito, in an effort to boost her own confidence as a Spirit World warrior.
- 12:30** Mob Psycho 100 (1-3, dubbed, TV-14)
Eighth-grader Shigeo "Mob" Kageyama has tapped into his inner wellspring of psychic prowess at a young age. But the power quickly proves a liability when he realizes the potential danger in his skills.
- 2:00** Shadows House (1-4, dubbed, TV-14)
High atop a cliff sits the mansion known as Shadows House, home to a faceless clan that pretends to live like nobles. They express their emotions through living dolls that also endlessly clean the home of soot. One such servant, Emilico, aids her master Kate as they learn more about themselves and the mysteries of the house.
- 3:30** Revolutionary Girl Utena (1-3, subtitled, 14+)
Content note: intimate partner violence, bullying
After the deaths of her parents, Utena Tenjou was consoled by a traveling prince, and vowed to become a prince herself. The prince gave Utena a strange rose-crest ring and promised they would meet again someday. A few years later, Utena attends Ohtori Academy, where she is drawn into a dangerous game. Duelists with rings like

Utena's compete for a unique prize: the Rose Bride, Anthy Himemiya. When Utena wins Anthy in a duel, she realizes that to free Anthy and discover the school's secrets, she has only one option: to revolutionize the world.

- 5:00** Nichijou - My Ordinary Life (1-3, subtitled, 14+)
Nichijou primarily focuses on the daily antics of a trio of childhood friends—high school girls Mio Naganohara, Yuuko Aioi and Mai Minakami—whose stories soon intertwine with the young genius Hakase Shinonome, her robot caretaker Nano, and their talking cat Sakamoto. With every passing day, the lives of these six, as well as of the many people around them, experience both the calms of normal life and the insanity of the absurd
- 6:30** The Promised Neverland (1-4, dubbed, TV-14)
Emma, Norman, and Ray are the three most brilliant children the Grace Field House has produced in decades. Unlike in a typical orphanage, they eat well and receive an intensive education. But something's not right. When six-year-old Conny is "adopted" by foster parents, she forgets her favorite stuffed rabbit. When Emma and Norman sneak out to return it, they realize exactly why they had always been isolated from the outside world.
- 8:00** Beastars (1-5, subtitled, TV-MA)
Content note: depictions of murder, sexual situations
At Cherryton Academy in a world of anthropomorphic animals, tension between carnivores and herbivores reaches a peak when Tem, an alpaca in the drama club, is killed and eaten by an unidentified carnivore. Legoshi, a gray wolf on the stage crew, stands guard while Tem's replacement rehearses, but soon finds himself struggling with his own carnivorous instincts when Haru, a small rabbit scorned by her schoolmates, passes by.
- 10:00** Puella Magi Madoka Magica the Movie Part III: Rebellion (dubbed, not rated)
Content note: violent and frightening scenes
The magical girls of Mitakihara happily live their lives, occasionally fighting off evil, but otherwise going about their peaceful, everyday routines. However, Homura Akemi feels that something is wrong with this unusually pleasant atmosphere—though the others remain oblivious, she can't help but suspect that there is more to what is going on than meets the eye: someone who should not exist is currently present to join in on their activities.

Sunday – Open 8am-6pm

- 8:00** Natsume's Book of Friends (1-4, subtitled, TV-14)
While most fifteen-year-old boys harbor secrets that are related to girls, Takashi Natsume has a peculiar and terrifying secret involving youkai: for as long as he can remember, he has been constantly chased by these spirits. Natsume soon discovers that his deceased grandmother Reiko had passed on to him the Yuujinchou, or "Book of Friends," which contains the names of the spirits whom she brought under her control.
- 9:30** Bunny Drop (1-4, subtitled, TV-G)
Going home for his grandfather's funeral, thirty-year-old Daikichi is floored to discover that the old man had a child with a younger lover. The rest of his family is equally shocked and embarrassed by this surprise development, and not one of them wants anything to do with the silent little girl, Rin. In a fit of anger, Daikichi decides to take her in himself.
- 11:00** Martian Successor Nadesico (1-5, subtitled, TV-PG)
The Earth, its moon and its Martian colonies are under alien attack, but the war against the "Jovian lizards" has, so far, been nothing short of a series of disasters. Disgusted by the incompetence of Earth's military, the independent arms manufacturer Nergal builds its own space battleship and plans to launch a desperate offensive to save humanity. But due to a shortage of trained soldiers, they've assembled the most unorthodox crew to ever launch into orbit!
- 1:00** Last Exile (1-3, subtitled, TV-PG)
When vanship pilot Claus Valca and his best friend Lavie Head take on a high-rated delivery to bring an orphan girl named Alvis Hamilton to the battleship Silvana, they get dragged into a much greater conflict that pits them against the might of the Guild.
- 2:30** Planetes (1-3, subtitled, 13+)
In the year 2075, mankind has reached a point where journeying between Earth, the moon and the space stations is part of daily life. However, the progression of technology in space has also resulted in the problem of the

space debris, which can cause excessive and even catastrophic damage to spacecraft and equipment. This is the story of Technora's Debris Collecting section, its EVA worker, Hachirota "Hachimaki" Hoshino, and the newcomer to the group, Ai Tanabe.

4:00 Lupin III: The First (dubbed, not rated)

Content note: violence, guns, some mild blood

The iconic "gentleman thief" Lupin III returns in an action-packed, continent-spanning adventure, as Lupin III and his colorful underworld companions race to uncover the secrets of the mysterious Bresson Diary, before it falls into the hands of a dark cabal that will stop at nothing to resurrect the Third Reich
