You, the scion of pharaonic wealth and power, the heir to generations of opulence and dominion, born comfortable, groomed to success, and indoctrinated into your family's righteousness, have cultivated a secret truth. It's a truth not spoken in your marbled halls or whispered on the deck of the spare yacht. But it's a truth. You can escape. You can thrive. All it takes is ending the family fortune. The more conspicuously and garishly you go about this, the less evident it will be. The world thinks you're right by virtue of your station, after all, so go out and blow it all extravagantly.

Plutocrats is a send-up of our contemporary situation, a situation that conflates wealth and virtue and lavishly rewards the worst in us. It's satire, and it's a fun catharsis to blow through the absurdity. You'll bid for everything from spare jets to production companies to endowments that you can assign subordinates to work in an attempt to build a silly, money-losing enterprise. It's easy to fail forward as a plutocrat, however, so find opportunities to stick other players with your unearned cash and dodge the windfalls that keep coming your way.
